### Power School, School Engage and Passwords

SchoolEngage is the online platform used by our parents/guardians to:

- Register a student who is new to The Centre for Learning@HOME
- Register new members of the family
- Register a previous student returning to The Centre for Learning@HOME
- Complete required forms as required; like the Home Education Program Plan, reimbursement forms, resource requests etc.

PowerSchool is our student information system. SchoolEngage can be found by either directly logging into SchoolEngage or by accessing it through PowerSchool.

Your username and password for SchoolEngage is different than your login to PowerSchool. If you can't remember your login and/or password, please reach out to your FSC if the 'forgot password' button does not work.

### Canvas, Google, Office 365

Canvas is our online classroom and learning management system. Canvas is a virtual school and is home to our teacher classrooms, a principal's office, bulletin boards with announcements, mailboxes for submitting assignments and tests.

Your student will access Canvas using their Christ the Redeemer Google account. You will receive an email the week before school starts with details about how to access Canvas, using Google. Please keep track of your login details. It is separate from Power School/School Engage.

Should they need it, students also have access to the Office 365 suite. Contact your FSC if you need to get set up with Office 365.

#### **Textbooks and Resources**

All required textbooks and resources will be mailed directly to your home if you live outside of Okotoks. If you live in and around Okotoks you will be asked to pick up textbooks at our office. If you have not received textbooks by the end of September, please contact your Family Service Coordinator.

### **Ordering Resources**

Alberta Education does not provide funding directly to students in an Online or Print Based program. The Centre for Learning@HOME can support students with a limited number of resources to ensure students have what they NEED to complete their schooling. Students have a Student Resource Allocation (SRA) and this can be used to request resources. There is a limit to how much we can provide to a student each year.

Technology resources are on loan from the school and will need to be returned when a student is no longer registered with the school. All other resources are considered consumable and do not need to be returned or replenished.

If you would like to borrow technology or order consumable supplies please contact your FSC for the appropriate order form.

## **Program Enhancement Events**

Families are welcome to participate in the many activities and events throughout the province. When registering you can choose to pay for the event yourself or to use Student Resource Allocation (SRA) and the school will cover the cost of the event.
