Date of 1st and 2nd Visit:

- We can meet in person at your home or at a local coffee shop or library. It is important that your child(ren) is present for the visit. Be sure to let your Visiting Teacher know early in the Term what dates will not work so they can plan accordingly.
- Be sure to have your Home Education Program Plan (HEPP) completed in School Engage and available to view by September 30th or by our first visit so that we can reference it throughout your visit. There will be one HEPP per child in your house taking Home Education. In it you are to list subjects, curriculum resources, goals, activities, teaching and assessment methods
- The Home Education Program Plan (HEPP) is a legal document required by the Alberta government for students in both a Home Education or Shared Responsibility program to be completed for each child. It will be uploaded to Alberta Education at year end and becomes part of the school records.
- Please note – this document is **NOT** your HEPP; your HEPP is located in School Engage. This document is for planning your talking and discussion points during your visit.
- Point form is fine too! The notes from your HEPP are used to help the Visiting Teacher write up a “Home Education Progress Report” that is then uploaded to Alberta Education at year end and becomes part of the school records.
- On the day of the visit, have your current books bookmarked to your present page, a book that your child(ren) would like to read and a writing sample handy to share.
- Block off about an hour to hour and ½ for one child, 2 hours for 2 children and about 2 ½ hours for 3 children.
- The Parent Assessment is also now included in this document for each subject at the top. In Home Education, the parent does the assessment of the child. Please do your best to fill it out for each child. You can talk more about this with your Visiting Teacher at the visit. Choosing 1,2 or 3 for LA and Math and using C, N/C or N/A for other courses works great. These assessment values will appear in your Term 2 Report.
