View Your Course Selections

Beginning August 25:

Parents can log into PowerSchool to review a list of their child's course selections under the Student Reports icon on the left side menu. Next click CFL Course Confirmation. Prior to this date parents will be able to see their child's course selections in SchoolEngage. If you need to re-set your PowerSchool login information, please contact your Family Service Coordinator (FSC).

Getting Started:

Students will receive their username and password for Canvas, our learning management system, during the last week of August. All students and parents must complete the school's online orientation in Canvas prior to the first day of classes. The orientation icon will be available on students' Canvas dashboards by 1 pm August 25.

Class Schedules

Students should have their semester one core course icons visible on their Canvas dashboard by August 30. Please note that class times will be posted on teachers' course home pages in Canvas. If your child does not see the icon for a semester one core subject by the end of the day on August 30, please inform your FSC.

Semester two icons will not be available until the semester turnover at the end of January.

High School students need a myPass account. myPass is an Alberta Education self-service website for students to view diploma results, request and pay for diploma rewrites, to order transcripts and access your Detailed Academic Report (DAR). Students need to register for a myPass account through Alberta Education.
