

How to complete Home Education Program Plan (HEPP) Form Due September 30th of each school year.


SchoolEngage (SE) is accessed from PowerSchool (PS): <https://redeemer.powerschool.com/public/home.html>

You must always login as a **PARENT** when filling out forms in SE, so that you will have a SUBMIT button at the end of the form. *Student logins are not able to submit SE forms.* If you require assistance with your PS login, please contact your Family Service Coordinator.

Once logged into PS, launch SE from the bottom of the left menu.



Once in SE, click on Students, then your child(s) name that you need to fill out a HEPP for.



Look on the right side of your screen, under FORMS to access the Home Education Program Plan.

3. Remember to **SAVE** often.
4. Do **NOT** remove anything from the HEPP!
5. When filling in Specific Subject Areas:
 - a. Ensure your HEPP will match receipts for reimbursement (if unsure about an item, contact your FSC prior to purchase).
 - b. Details are helpful, instead of - Music: piano. We want to see Music: piano lessons with Okotoks Music Centre and piano books from Long and McQuade

If at anytime you are unsure about what to include on your HEPP, your Visiting Teacher and/or Family Service Coordinator (FSC) can assist you.
